

Adjunct Instructor – Science Courses

Responsibilities:

1. Teach lecture and lab portions of one or more courses which may include: undergraduate microbiology, graduate anatomy, undergraduate anatomy & physiology, undergraduate immunology, undergraduate biochemistry and/or undergraduate cellular and molecular biology
2. Assess student work
3. Participate in School and College-wide affairs when appropriate, and
4. Contribute to program-level assessment efforts

Qualifications:

- Ph.D. or doctoral degree in Biology, Anatomy, Physiology, Microbiology and/or Biochemistry or a closely related field to the course(s) of instruction.
- Educational degrees must be from a regionally accredited institution.
- Candidates must possess excellent organizational and communication skills (verbal and written). Teaching experience is preferred, with special consideration given to applicants with experience teaching at the college level.
