DAN 347 R – ADVANCED/INTERMEDIATE TAP

This tap class is designed to further the dancer's training in musical theatre and rhythm tap dance.

Warm-up and exercises include advanced time steps and turns. More intricate combinations will be taught in order to prepare the dancer for auditions. MWF 3-4:10 second 8-week session
