 - c. Organic Chemistry II (lecture + laboratory; 4 credit hours)
 - d. Genetics (lecture + laboratory; 4 credit hours)
 - e. Cellular & Molecular Biology Techniques laboratory (2 credit hours)
 - f. Calculus (3 credit hours)
 - g. Health Behavior or Introduction to Public Health (3 credit hours)
2. Assess student work
3. Participate in School and College-wide affairs when appropriate, and
4. Contribute to program-level assessment efforts

Position Requirements

- Ph.D. or doctoral degree in relevant field related to the course(s) of instruction. Master's Degree or ABD + collegiate teaching experience will be considered.
- Educational degrees must be from a regionally accredited institution.
- Candidates must possess excellent organizational and communication skills (verbal and written). Teaching experience is preferred, with special consideration given to applicants with experience teaching in innovative and online/hybrid formats at the college level.
