- Maintain standards of academic integrity and student performance.
- Oversee clinical, laboratory, and simulation learning experiences.
- Participate in School and College-wide affairs when appropriate.
- Contribute to program-level assessment efforts.

1. Current active licensure to practice professional nursing in Missouri and has never been disciplined in any jurisdiction.
2. MS in Nursing from an Accredited College or University that includes a clinical component.
3. Record of clinical experience, more than 2 years.
4. Ability to flex teaching style to a wide-variety of learners.
5. Excellent collaborative and interpersonal communication skills.

Highly Desired:

1. DNP or PhD in Nursing from an Accredited College or University.
2. Experience teaching baccalaureate level nursing, prelicensure.
3. Ability and clinical experience across more than one specialty area.
4. Experience with accreditation and program assessment.
