

Assistant Professor - Chemistry



Stephens College invites applications for a full-time 9-month non-tenure track position in Chemistry in the Biology program within the School of Health Sciences. The ideal candidate will be able to develop and teach innovative, engaging, student-centered courses within the biology, integrative human biology and nursing majors in the following areas: general chemistry, organic chemistry, biochemistry and environmental chemistry. Preference will be given to candidates who have experience teaching clinically-relevant general chemistry content to nursing students. Faculty will be expected to engage undergraduate students in their research and scholarly agenda and mentor students completing their capstone research projects. Modest start-up research funds may be available, and possibility of a multi-year contract.

Job Duties:

1. Develop and teach undergraduate courses in chemistry
2. Academic advisement to undergraduate students
3. Develop and pursue a research and scholarly agenda with undergraduate students
4. Provide service to the college and profession
5. Assist in development of curricula and programs within the School of Health Sciences
