The Clinical Faculty will:

- Support the mission vision, and ideals of the College and the Nursing program.
- Serve as adjunct teaching faculty in the Nursing Program with assigned teaching duties based on background and experience in clinical, laboratory, and simulation settings.
- Facilitate student experiential learning at practice sites.
- Coordinate learning experiences with the lead course instructor to help students achieve program learning outcomes.
- Maintain standards of academic integrity and student performance.
- Supervise student learning experiences with patients and health care team to ensure student and patient safety, while upholding clinical site (agency) policies.
- Build learning experiences that develop student skill and confidence in providing excellent nursing care.
- Facilitate student's ability to integrate with the health care team.
- Communicate learning needs to students, unit staff, unit director, and course faculty
- Evaluate and grade student performance and assignments.
- Maintain records of learning experiences.
- Assist in the development and evaluation of curricula and programs.
